2. **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

This report is submitted to the Committee in order to approve the draft Annual Report for the 2007/2008 financial year.

3. **BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 On 17th March 2008 the Committee approved the three year Corporate Strategy 2008-2011 and the Annual Service Plan 2008/2009. Both documents are forward looking and identify how our service is to be delivered. The draft Annual Report for 2007/2008 is a look back at the previous year's progress and reports the outcomes against the Best Value Performance Indicators (BVPIs). It should be noted that as of 1st April 2008 there is no longer a requirement to publish this information and, therefore, this will be the final document that details the BVPIs in this way.
