### 1. QUESTIONS ON DISCHARGE OF FUNCTIONS

#### RECOMMENDED

THAT the Authority nominate Councillor Eustace as Deputy Lead Member to answer questions on the discharge of the functions of the Authority as required by Section 41 of the Local Government Act 1985.

#### 2. PURPOSE

#### 3. BACKGROUND

Members of that Council can put questions to a Member who is nominated by the Authority for that purpose.
- 3.2 Although the Authority has responsibility for nominating Members, it is normal practice to seek the views of the district councils as to the person they wish to see nominated for this purpose.
