8/11 Standards Regime - Member Training

The Group received an update from the Monitoring Officer in relation to the Localism Act 2011 and in particular, the changes to the standards regime. Members noted that under the Act it would be a criminal offence to fail, without reasonable excuse, to comply with obligations to register or declare a personal interest.

Councillor Chambers reported that Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council was providing in-house training on the changes and members from Walsall would feedback to the Group.

The Group discussed the merits of providing annual declaration of interests to both their home authorities and the Fire Authority. It was felt that submitting declarations to both authorities was somewhat duplicitous. The Monitoring Officer would provide further guidance on this in due course.

Training on the Act and in particular the changes to the standards regime would be provided at a future Policy Planning Forum.
