1. 'GOING LOCAL: INVESTIGATIONS AND HEARINGS'

2. **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

This report is to raise Members' awareness of the processes around local investigations and hearings.

3. **BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 The Standards Board for England has produced a guidance DVD to support monitoring officers and Standards Committees in their work in investigating cases concerning potential breaches of the Members' Code of Conduct. The DVD uses a fictional case to illustrate a local investigation and hearing and highlights some of the challenges that may arise.
- 3.2 Arrangements have been made for the Committee to view the DVD at this meeting, and to use the programme as a tool for discussion. The purpose of the DVD is not to examine the detail of the fictional complaint but to identify how to carry out a fair and balanced local investigation and the best procedure for a professional and effective hearing.
