23/07 Annual Report 2006/07

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25/07 Waste Transfer Station adjacent to Hay Mills Fire Station

The Committee was informed that an objection had been lodged in respect of a planning objection submitted by the operators of the Waste Transfer Station situated at 190 Speedwell Road, Tysley, due to the potential for the proposed extension of opening hours to increase the dust pollution currently affecting the adjacent Hay Mills Fire Station. It had been necessary to take this action as a matter of urgency to comply with the timescales of the planning process, following legal advice. Details of the objection were submitted.

The situation with regard to dust pollution at Hay Mills Fire Station was being monitored.

Resolved that the action taken to lodge an objection with Birmingham City Council in respect of the planning application be affirmed.

26/07 Tenders for the Construction of a Training Facility

The Committee opened six tenders received for the construction of a training facility, in the following amounts:-

£742,262.00; £818,729.00; £854,173.00; £909,227.00; £947,121.00; £1,066,649.00.

The estimated cost of the work was £900,000.
