2. **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

This report is submitted for Members of the Audit Committee to approve the Authority's Statement of Accounts for the financial year ended 31 March 2017.

3. **BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 require that the accounts be submitted to Members for approval by the end of September.
- 3.2 It is a further requirement of the Regulations that Members are informed of any material changes required by the external auditors. Audit work on the Statement of Accounts has been substantially completed.
- 3.3 The Accounts show net cost of services in 2016/2017 of £107.2 million including an appropriation to earmarked reserves of £3.569 million. General balances have increased by £0.003 million to £9.236 million.
- 3.4 The total Provision of Services in 2016/2017 shows a deficit of £58.881 million, after allowing for the required accounting treatment of pensions governed by International Accounting Standard Nineteen (IAS19). Capital expenditure totalled £3.677 million.
