## 54/08 Post of Chief Fire Officer

The Committee considered a report on the post of the Chief Fire Officer. The Clerk informed the Committee of the proposed process for the appointment of a successor, following the resignation of the former Chief Fire Officer, and a draft timetable for the appointment; and outlined the interim management arrangements.

- (3) that the use of Executive Search specialists to aid the recruitment of the Chief Fire Officer be approved;
- (4) that the composition of the Appointments Committee be reviewed to ensure that all constituent District Councils are represented thereon and that a further report be submitted in due course;
- (5) that, with effect from 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2008, Deputy Fire Chief Officer V Randeniya be appointed as Acting Chief Fire Officer until such time as a new appointment is made by the Authority on the same terms and conditions of service as the outgoing postholder;
- (6) that appointments be made to the resultant vacancies on the Corporate Board in accordance with West Midlands Fire Service recruitment protocols;
- (7) that the action taken by the Head of Human Resources, in accordance with Standing Order 17, in accepting the former Chief Fire Officer's resignation, be endorsed;
- (8) that the payment of a pension to the former Chief Fire Officer in accordance with the Firemen's Pension Scheme Order 1992 (as amended), be approved.
