### 29/06 Best Value Performance and Business Plan

# 33/06 <u>Governance Arrangements for Regional Fire Controls –</u> Consultation Response to the Department for Communities and Local Government

The Committee was asked to consider and approve the Authority's response to the consultation exercise carried out by the Department for Communities and Local Government on the proposed governance arrangements for Regional Fire Control Centres (RFCC).

The consultation document set out detailed proposals for Local Authority Control Companies (LACC) to be established to run the RFCCs. The Committee noted the overview and implications of the key criteria relating to the articles and memorandum of association and the structure and responsibilities of the LACCs, including liabilities and penalties. It was also noted that the LACC for the West Midlands Region was required to be established by 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007.

The initial costs of setting up the LACCs would be met directly by the Government and these costs included provision for legal work that may be required on the memorandum and articles of association. The business case and associated costs for each constituent Fire and Rescue Authority (FRA) were yet to be announced by the Government therefore it was not possible to determine the full financial implications for the Authority. It was noted however that the contribution from West Midlands was likely to be the highest.

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Further reports would be submitted in due course.

**Resolved** that approval be given to the Authority's response to the Government's consultation exercise on the proposed governance arrangements for the Regional Fire Control Centres, as now submitted.
